

SESSION 5 BIBLE VERSES – KEEP IT SHUT

James 1:19-20 *NIV* Listening and Doing ¹⁹ My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, ²⁰ because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.

Ephesians 4:26-27 *NIV* ²⁶ “In your anger do not sin”^[a]: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, ²⁷ and do not give the devil a foothold.

Ephesians 4:26-27 *ESV* ²⁶ Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, ²⁷ and give no opportunity to the devil.

Ephesians 4:26-27 *Good News* ²⁶ If you become angry, do not let your anger lead you into sin, and do not stay angry all day. ²⁷ Don't give the Devil a chance.

Ephesians 4:26-27 *NKJV* ²⁶ “Be angry, and do not sin”: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, ²⁷ nor give place to the devil.

Ephesians 4:26-27 *The Message* ²⁶⁻²⁷ Go ahead and be angry. You do well to be angry—but don't use your anger as fuel for revenge. And don't stay angry. Don't go to bed angry. Don't give the Devil that kind of foothold in your life.

Proverbs 15:1 *NIV* **15** A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

1 Corinthians 15:31 *NIV* ³¹ I face death every day—yes, just as surely as I boast about you in Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 15:13 *NIV* ¹³ Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

Ephesians 4:31-32 *NIV* ³¹ Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. ³² Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Colossians 3:8 *NIV* ⁸ But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips.

Proverbs 29:22 *NIV* ²² An angry person stirs up conflict, and a hot-tempered person commits many sins.

Ecclesiastes 5:6 *NIV* ⁶ Do not let your mouth lead you into sin.

Matthew 5:22 *NIV* ²² But I tell you that anyone who is angry with a brother or sister^{[a][b]} will be subject to judgment. Again, anyone who says to a brother or sister, ‘Raca,’^[c] is answerable to the court. And anyone who says, ‘You fool!’ will be in danger of the fire of hell.

Proverbs 15:18 NIV ¹⁸ A hot-tempered person stirs up conflict, but the one who is patient calms a quarrel.

Proverbs 17:14 NIV ¹⁴ Starting a quarrel is like breaching a dam; so drop the matter before a dispute breaks out.

Proverbs 17:19 NIV ¹⁹ Whoever loves a quarrel loves sin; whoever builds a high gate invites destruction.
